Students successfully completing the requirements will be awarded the American Red Cross CPR for the Professional Rescuer, Title 22 First Aid, Lifeguarding, and Water Safety Instructor Certificates. 54 hours lecture and 54 hours laboratory. A fee of \$82.45 for required certificates will be charged to the student and is not covered by BOGW.(Letter grade only)
